- Teacher Guided Learning Teachers structure the teaching and learning activities to ensure the learning process engages the students well in the process of discovery.
- Peer to Peer Learning Discussion forums and peer to peer tutoring are highly encouraged.
- Digital Learning Digital Learning is integrated into the curriculum. Students provide their own laptop/tablet.
- Leadership Training There is a major emphasis on the ability to lead a team and being part of a team.
- Flexible Learning Spaces allow for the implementation of different learning strategies.

1 Fill in an online form from the WWCC website - www.kids.nsw.gov.au or call the helpline to have someone fill in a form for you (1300 555 727). You will be issued with an application number.

2 Take this application number to the local motor registry with appropriate identification and they will then issue you with a WWCC Number.

The cost is currently \$80 and the WWCC remains current for five years. This WWCC is transferable amongst employers. You may be able to claim this expense as a tax deduction as it is a requirement for your employment when you lodge your tax return. Please consult with your tax advisor.
