Primary Scholarship for 2018

The Kingdom Culture Christian School Board is pleased to be offering scholarships to students entering Years 2-6 in 2018. The purpose of the KCCS Scholarship program is to encourage the giftedness of students in the context of the school's vision and mission statements as expressed in *The KCCS Aims, Goals and Educational Philosophy.* This involves the encouragement and nurture of excellence in the development of student gifts and character formation that are core to the distinctive identity and culture of KCCS.

The Scholarship Categories include:

• The Academic Scholarship

The Board of Kingdom Culture Christian School offers this scholarship to encourage a student who has shown a commitment to achieving excellence in their learning in at least two areas of English, Mathematics, Science, Geography, History, Creative Arts and Personal Development and Health. A student will be expected to use their gifts to contribute to the building of the learning and service culture of KCCS.

• The Creative Arts Scholarship

The Board of Kingdom Culture Christian School offers this scholarship to encourage a student who has shown a gift in an area of Creative Arts - Visual Arts and/or Drama and/or Dance and/or Music and/or Singing. A student will be expected to use their gifts to contribute to the building of the learning and service culture of KCCS. This will also involve participating in special-events organised by the school.

• The Technology Scholarship

The Board of Kingdom Culture Christian School offers this scholarship to encourage a student who shows creativity and aptitude in the use of technology in the areas of electronics, woodwork, robotics, Lego construction, coding or digital technology. A student will be expected to use their gifts to contribute to the building of the learning and service culture of KCCS.

• The Leadership Scholarship

The Board of Kingdom Culture Christian School offers this scholarship to encourage a student who shows a capacity to lead and influence others. The student will have demonstrated depth of character and experience in school or external activities such as public speaking, group leadership and decision making. A student will be expected to use their gifts to contribute to the building of the learning and service culture of KCCS.

• The All-Rounder Scholarship

The Board of Kingdom Culture Christian School offers this scholarship to encourage a student who has shown a commitment in engaging with every aspect of their learning and school activities in two or more categories of Academic, Creative Arts, Technology and Leadership. The student has demonstrated excellence through their Primary School education. A student will be expected to use their gifts to contribute to the building of the learning and service culture of KCCS. Each of these scholarships provides support for a primary student at Kingdom Culture Christian School during his/her time at the school, subject to an annual review. The scholarship will meet the full-cost of the student tuition fees.

Basic Eligibility

- The parent/child fulfils the KCCS Enrolment conditions
- The child enters Year 2 or 3, or 4, or 5, or 6 next year

Selection Criteria for all KCCS Scholarships:

- Evidence of a successful transition and participation in a primary school environment.
- Demonstration of a capacity for learning reflected in effort and achievement.
- Evidence of aptitude in the category of the Scholarship application being made.
- Agreement to the terms and conditions of the KCCS Scholarship

Selection Process

The Selection Panel makes the final decision regarding the award of a Scholarship based on the student meeting the criteria and ascertained through an interview and an appropriate test/ audition. The Panel will consist of a Board member, Principal and teacher.

The Application Process

- A family whose child is not enrolled at KCCS, can make application for a Scholarship by obtaining and completing a Scholarship Application form and an Enrolment form obtained by emailing the Office Manager at <u>contact@kccs.nsw.edu.au</u> and payment of a \$100 nonrefundable application fee.
- A family whose child is already enrolled at KCCS does not need to complete an Enrolment Form but must pay the \$100.00 non-refundable application fees for the scholarship.
- An Application must include:
 - A completed KCCS Scholarship Application Form and Enrolment Form (where needed)
 - Any documentation relevant to the criteria upon which the Application is made.
 - An Acceptance of a KCCS Scholarship
 - \circ The school will notify parents if an application has been successful/unsuccessful
 - Within 1 week of receiving notification that the Scholarship has been granted, parents of a child not currently enrolled at the school must have completed and returned the offer of Enrolment Acceptance form.

Additional Information

- Applicants may apply in one or more categories but must complete an application form for each category. Each application will be considered separately.
- All applications will be kept confidential.
